Mayor Collins appointed Jeannie Crees as Mayor Pro Tem.

Motion by P O'Neil seconded by C Tracy to approve the agenda. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by P O'Neil seconded by C Tracy to approve the closure of 8<sup>th</sup> St for the dance at Mallory Park on August 8, 2020. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by L Hamilton seconded by P O'Neil to approve Resolution 2020-21 regarding a 10 year graduated tax abatement for the new home built at 728 Lyon St. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by J Crees seconded by C Tracy to approve the Casey's Liquor License upgrade. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by J Crees seconded by L Hamilton to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2020-330 Golf Carts and UTV's. All ayes, motion carried.
