

Murray Regular Council Meeting:
February 5, 2018

Mayor Pro Tem Jeannie Crees called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Present Dean Robins, Jeff Robbins, Lois Hamilton, and Richard Hays; Absent Mayor Scott Busick.

Motion by D Robins seconded by J Robbins to approve the agenda. All ayes, motion carried.

Mayor Busick arrived at 7:03 pm.

Motion by L Hamilton seconded by R Hays to open the public hearing on proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the 2018 Storm Drainage Improvements Project. All ayes, motion carried. No public comments.

Motion by J Crees seconded by D Robins to close the public hearing on proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the 2018 Storm Drainage Improvements Project. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by J Crees seconded by D Robins to approve Resolution 2018-6 approving and confirming plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the 2018 Murray Storm Drainage Improvements Projects. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by J Robbins seconded by L Hamilton to approve the Consideration of Bids for the 2018 Storm Drainage Improvements Project. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by J Crees seconded by D Robins to approve Resolution 2018-7 awarding contract for the 2018 Storm Drainage Improvements Project to Boyd Construction with a bid in the amount of \$574,292.62. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by J Crees seconded by R Hays to approve Resolution 2018-8 to fix a date for a public hearing on a proposal to enter into a Storm Water Revenue Loan Agreement and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$610,000 for April 2, 2018 at 7pm at Murray City Hall. Motion by D Robins seconded by J Crees to approve the Clarke County Sheriff 28e Agreement with a cost of \$36,000 per year for a minimum of 100 hours of patrol in

Murray per month. All ayes, motion carried.
