Motion by L Hamilton seconded by K Frederick to approve awarding the Murray Rec Complex contract to low bidder Boyd Construction for Phase 1. All ayes, motion carried.

1. Fees. The base fee for water service, used or available, for each residential, commercial, industrial, or institutional premise is \$12.09.
2. A fee will be assessed for every 1000 gallons of water used according to the following base schedule.




Motion by L Hamilton seconded by R Hays to approve the agenda. All yes, motion carried.
